

6 Policy Writing Workshop: Part 1

SV presented the Planning Framework and the different terms, documents including the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) and the Development Framework - made up of the Core Strategy (until replaced with the new Local Plan), Development Management DPD and Site Allocations DPD.

The Spixworth Neighbourhood Plan, once 'made', will become part of the Development Framework.

The second part of the presentation outlined the importance of the Basic Conditions that examiners use to test neighbourhood plans, the aspects of drafting policies, scope, style, language and structure – with some do's and don'ts.

The Policy Writing Template was introduced with an example of how a policy could be developed to resolve an issue. In policy writing it is easier to identify - what the issue is - and then - list out what the result would look like or what you wouldn't want to happen.
