9.1 HIGHWAYS AND AMENITIES

9.1 Councillors discussed the parking issue on a piece of grassed land located on Orchard Road. Broadland District Council has confirmed that the Parish Council own this grassed area. Clerk to schedule in a site visit for Councillors to look at and decide what needs doing to resolve issue.

9.2 Clerk circulated revised allotment plan to all councillors. A hard copy of the plan was shown at the meeting. Councillors agreed that it looks ok, no further comment was made. Awaiting for final sign of documents from Clerks Wells.

9.3 The Parish Council received two invoices from TT Jones Streetlighting to replace 8 lamp columns. The Parish Council only instructed TT Jones to Straighten and re concrete one post and replace another. A meeting was held on the 19th March 2018 with TT Jones and the Parish Council to discuss the outstanding invoices. It was agreed by the Councillors that the Parish Council only pay for the streetlight columns that were instructed for repair.

9.4 The Parish Council Street lighting contract with TT Jones finished on the 31st March. Clerk went out to tender for 3 contractor quotes. Quotes were received from Cozens and TT Jones. Clerk read out Cozens contract requirements and cost. Council proposed and agreed to accept Cozens quote for a 3 year period.

9.5 It was reported to the clerk that there has been a parking issue on Park road with a vehicle continually parking on the grass verge and churning it up. Clerk to add to site visit schedule for Councillors to have a look.

9.6 Councillor V Barrell erected SAM2 sign on post 615, Buxton Road, East side to monitor traffic speeds. Data circulated to Councillors.

10 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANS

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Councillor S Vincent provided an update on the latest information for Spixworth Neighbourhood Plan.

Vision and objective has been agreed, steering group met last week looking at data sets and policy writing. The next Steering Group will be held on 9th May 2018. The Parish Council website now has a Neighbourhood Plan page with all the latest news content and a timeline showing what has been done with the plan to date. There is also a list of all the agenda and Steering Group Minutes.

10.1 Proposal for Community Transport in Spixworth- the Parish Council had received a request from a Parishioner to consider community transport for Spixworth Neighbourhood Plan so people could have transport for doctor/dentist appointments etc. Councillor K Vincent looked into this request and brought to the meeting for views from other Councillors. Further work would be needed to look into requirements of carrying this out including the need for a volunteer driver. Clerk to contact Norfolk County Council Transport Department.
